Job Description

Role and Responsibilities

- Tankermen are responsible for ensuring the safe transport of product.
- Must be physically fit
- Able to lift heavy objects
- Able to climb ladders
- Able to move heavy equipment
- Able to work both indoors and outdoors in all weather conditions
- Must be knowledgeable of all rules and regulations of their duties
- Able to ensure that cargo is contained and transported safely.
- In case of an emergency, they must know the standard emergency procedures and take appropriate action
- Responsible for the operation and ensuring that all equipment is up-to-code
- Ability to fix potential problems ahead of time to prevent accidents.
- Trained to use a variety of tools in the assistance of an emergency, such as a breach in containment
- Follow all U.S. Coast Guard regulations and requirements in order to ensure employee safety and vessel compliance.
- Assist in tow work and continue deckhand duties when not tanking
- Follow vessel transfer procedures.
- All other duties assigned.

Preferred Skills

- Computer skills, including Microsoft Outlook, Word and Excel
- Knowledge of Refrigeration, A/C and heating systems.
- Knowledge of PLC's
- Skills in the areas of Electrical, Mechanical, Pneumatics, Diesel, and Plumbing.
